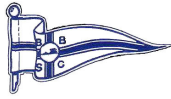

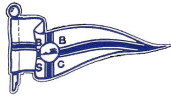
## The Port Hacking - Batemans Bay Coastal Regatta 2007



- In consideration of the Organising Authority and Race Committee (the Authority) accepting my boat's entry:
1. I agree to be bound by and comply with the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, Yachting Australia's Prescriptions to those Rules and its Special Regulations (as amended by the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions) and the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions.
  2. I agree that my participation in the regatta series or race is at my own risk.
  3. I agree not to make any claim against the Authority for any damage, injury or loss sustained or caused by participating in the regatta, series or race or as a result of an occurrence following the finish of the regatta, series or race.
  4. I agree to indemnify the Authority, and to keep it indemnified, together with any other organization or person involved in the conduct of the regatta, series or race, against suits, actions or demands which may be brought in respect of any damage, injury or loss sustained or caused by me in the course of participating in the regatta, series or race or as a result of an occurrence following the finish of the regatta, series or race.
  5. I agree to exonerate the Authority together with any other organization or person involved in the conduct of the regatta, series or race from any damage, injury or loss sustained or caused to me whether due to alleged negligence or otherwise.
  6. I acknowledge that rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 states:  
**"The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone."**
  7. I acknowledge that Yachting Australia's Special Regulation 1.02 states:  
**"1.02.1 The safety of a boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the owner, or the owner's representative, who shall do their best to ensure that the boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by an experienced crew who have undergone appropriate training and are physically fit to face bad weather. He must be satisfied as to the soundness of hull, spars, rigging, sails and all gear. He shall ensure that all safety equipment is properly maintained and stowed and that the crew knows where it is kept and how it is to be used. Attention is drawn to 2.04 which specifies the crew experience required for some races.**  
**1.02.2 Neither the establishment of these Special Regulations, their use by race organizers, nor the inspection of a boat under these Regulations in any way limits or reduces the complete and unlimited responsibility of the owner or owner's representative.**  
**1.02.3 The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone – RRS Fundamental Rule 4"**
  8. I accept the Authority's disclaimer that:
    - (a) A person participating in a race does so entirely at his or her own risk and responsibility.
    - (b) the Authority, the Race Officer, the Equipment Auditor, or any other person organizing a race is not responsible for:
      - (i) the seaworthiness of a participating boat;
      - (ii) the sufficiency or adequacy of her equipment; or
      - (iii) damage, injury or loss which may result, directly or indirectly, from preparing for, or participating in, a race or from an occurrence following the finish of the race.
  9. My boat complies, and will be maintained to comply, with all Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008, Yachting Australia's Prescriptions to those Rules and its Special Regulations (as amended by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions).
  10. I declare that the boat is covered by a current insurance policy which extends to the races entered and is covered by a Third Party and Third Party Property Insurance cover for the sum of at least \$5,000,000 and that these insurance covers will be current for the period of the regatta.

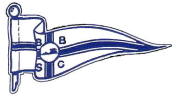
